

Program Cook - Overnight Camps and Adult Programs (Summer/Part Time)

Come join Wilderness Awareness School's summer programs and help bring sustenance and good humor to our students and staff. We have positions available for head cook at our semi-wild base camp in Duvall, WA. These may be filled by one person with plenty of energy and commitment or ideally shared by two to three cooks working different weeks.

Location: Our base camp in the foothills of the Cascade Mountains (Duvall, WA) - 45 min. from Seattle, WA

Start Date(s): Programs run July 11-17, July 18-24, July 25-30, July 30-August 1, August 1-6, August 8-13, and August 15-21.

Responsibilities:

Facilitate and implement all facets of meal delivery for a group of up to 45 students and staff. Includes:

- Following a pre-set menu with opportunities for creativity and meeting dietary needs of participants and staff.
- Coordination with program staff on timing and delivery of meals.
- Food prep, cooking and serving.
- Coordination and supervision of kitchen volunteers (including participant volunteers).
- Maintenance of kitchen facilities with a high standard of organization and cleanliness.
- Monitoring of food supplies and efficient use of ingredients on hand.
- Restocking of food supplies as needed (store, bulk, farmers market).
- Responsible handling of money and receipts when relevant.

Qualifications:

- 1) Flexible, responsible, good humored, enthusiastic and team oriented.
- 2) High level of skill with and commitment to healthy communication.
- 2) Experience with food service for large groups. Camp experiences a plus.
- 3) Must enjoy being around youth and adults!
- 4) Ability to lift 50 pounds.
- 5) Willingness to work hard.
- 6) Clean driving record and access to personal vehicle.

Compensation/Benefits:

- \$675/week (Duvall programs)
- On-site housing included in compensation.

Other Information:

- A background check is required for this position.
