DATES AND SCHEDULE

RESPONSIBILITIES

Assist lead instructors with small groups of students ages 6-12 in weeklong Summer Day Camps using Wilderness Awareness School's Awakening Inquiry curriculum.

QUALIFICATIONS

The only requirements are that you are enthusiastic about sharing your knowledge and appreciation of nature in a summer camp experience. Previous experience in leadership and teaching is helpful but not required.

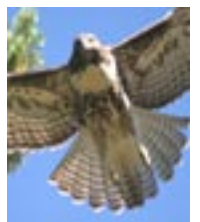


LOCATIONS
