Directions for Wilderness Awareness School's Campus

Our campus consists of 60 acres of mature and second growth forest as well as a pond and wetlands. The campus is adjacent to private and state forest lands of the Cascade foothills.

Coho Ridge Parking: (park here if in doubt)

- 1. Follow directions and CONTINUE on 320th Ave. NE until you reach the gravel road.
- 2. Please limit your speed to 10 MPH on the gravel road to protect our students, wildlife, neighboring pets, and your vehicle.
- 3. Continue past the horse property and a residential house. **Coho Ridge Parking** is on the left. Look for a wooden Wilderness Awareness School Sign at the entrance. **This is the main parking area.**
- 4. After you park, walk down the trail marked with red bandanas to get to the main part of Linne Doran.

If directed to park at the Linne Doran Parking Lot:

- Keep following the gravel road straight past the second Wooden WAS Sign. You will
 pass a driveway to the left for our neighbor "Mosswood Hollow" and a driveway to the
 right. (0.2 miles)
- 2. About 200 ft after the sign you'll see our **Linne Doran parking area** on the left. Please pull in and park here.
- 3. Walk up the gravel road and take the right fork to our campus.

To find your program location:

- 1. **Cedar Lodge** is our main indoor classroom it's a 2-story brown building with a covered porch.
- 2. To get to **Wolf Den** (the yurt) continue on the path to the right of Cedar Lodge and take the first path to the right.
- 3. To get to **Malalo Ya Chui**, continue on the path to the right of Cedar Lodge and a few hundred feet past the Wolf Den trail to a wide trail on the right which leads to Malalo.
